Through social media I found out that you are looking to change boundaries and put me in with an area associated with Fairfield.

I was only aware of this 6 days ago and a kind neighbor asked me if I had read about it ... she was told we were consulted. I was not consulted and was not aware of any proposals.

I attended a meeting this morning at 10.30 and found that 50 others in attendance were also not aware other than through the kindness of others.

I therefore want you to be made aware of my views and my feelings

I find it very stressful indeed that after living at my address over 25 years I am now flung into this uncertain situation. Had I been informed I could have digested it, however I am being made to rush through my feelings in the hope that I am heard.

It would appear that you have determined the proposed changes by taking the A491 as your line in the sand, however Fairfield is south of the line along with Belbroughton. Belbroughton is the village I have supported, the friends I associate with, dine with and socialise with. I support the fund raising events to benefit the village and support its growth. However this growth it seems is to my detriment when you are looking at numbers.

I feel strongly that travel to schools from where we are is not supporting the Green awareness to reduce emissions as no one will be able to walk their children to school as they can now to the village. This further adds to the congestion on already burdened roads through Fairfield.

I appreciate that you say things will not change further, however this is a change that I do not support and respectfully ask that you leave us as we are.
