However, it is unclear if this has been accepted and will be implemented. Can this be clarified please?

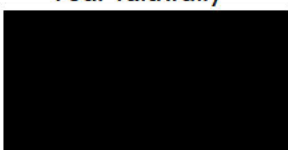
The Town Council has taken the opportunity to look again at the proposed warding arrangements.
