As a resident of Herrington, I strongly agree with the previous proposal for a Herrington Ward and disagree with the new St Chad's proposal. Plains Farm and Humbledon Hill are not in any way St Chad's: they are separated by main roads, have no public transport links and there are no central or even remotely mutually accessible community centres that could form the central hub of this ward. Residents at one end of the ward would find it impossible to access a ward surgery held at the other end of the ward if they did not drive. The Commission's report seems to already accept that this ward is not good enough. To local people this would not be something they would have conceived of as a 'local' community or even two communities.
