I do not believe the merging of Hastings Hill, Grindon, Springwell & Thorney Close with Pennywell & South Hylton is feasible.
Chester Road being an obvious hard border between the two areas, a difficult road to cross, having to use an appalling subway unusable after dark!
It is dirty, dismal & intimidating!!
It is like crossing no man's land!

There is no public transport link, even to get to Aldi or the nearest Metro Station at South Hylton (which is an expensive taxi ride away; although

promised as an 'integrated transport system').

Whereas HH, G, S & TC have good walking, cycling, road & bus links, sharing the Barnes Park extension.

I live in Hastings Hill & taught at Hasting Hill Primary in Thorney Close for 34 years & the schools in the present ward were once in the same education action zone & worked well together, most of the primary schools feeding Sandhill View. No busy 'A' road to cross to get there!

It makes much more sense to keep these areas together & represented by one set of councillors, who care for their area.
