Further to our 'e'mail dated 9 December 2023 with regards to the review being carried out by the Local Government Boundary Commission in relation to the Proposed Changes to Local Government Boundaries for Sandhill Ward, Sunderland.

We wish to confirm that we agree with the Commissions view to keep Hastings Hill together with Grindon, Springwell and Thorney Close as one Ward as it is at present and therefore represented by one set of Councillors.

In our view it seems logical and sensible to continue to keep these areas together and therefore be represented by one set of councillors.

Geographically the areas mentioned neighbour each other with major roads and arterial routes including the A19, A183 Chester Road and A690 Durham Road forming a very obvious natural boundary for the Ward in its present format

Further, all four areas share many facilities, including schools, shops, community groups, parks and other green spaces.

Road and public transport links between Hastings Hill, Grindon, Springwell and Thorney Close are good as are walking/cycling facilities.
