Cheshire East is far too large an authority. I was a former Councillor on both the old Macclesfield Borough Council and then in Cheshire East retiring a few years ago. When the previous review came through, we were presented with what felt like a definite decision, but it has never made real sense. There is no real cohesion between Macclesfield and Crewe. If Macclesfield is deemed too small, then a merger with Congleton would make sense as the two places have much more in common. It has been noticeable that money has been spent on HS2, which would not benefit this area at all, even if it should go ahead, rather than on local services. We badly need to get back to Macclesfield or if not deemed large enough, then Congleton too but no more. It makes for better running and more cohesion of the area.
