DUMBAH LANE

I am given to understand that there is a proposal to switch the houses in Bollington Dumbah Lane to Tytherington, Macclesfield.

I find this completely ridiculous having lived here since I was 6 now 76.

Dumbah Lane has historically been split in two presumably as the houses originally ended half way up the lane, but the Parish to Prestbury extends beyond and I live in the Parish of Prestbury. Indeed when we first moved in we had a Prestbury Telephone number 829119.

I recall in the early days my late Father a solicitor had note paper printed (a costly exercise at that time) and there being no name plates on the lane he contacted Bollington Council regarding the spelling of the lane. Was it "ER" "AR" or "AH" He was assured it was "ER"

Shortly afterwards name signs were erected spelling DUMBAH, Father took this up and was told that DUMBAH Lane was part of Prestbury the Parish and local Prestbury Council had all agreed.

Whilst this is rather immaterial, and passes into history it is now relevant as it shows then that this lane has always been regarded as Prestbury.

It has become even more relevant since the silk road was created in many ways cutting us from Bollington and I us the facilities in the village of Prestbury shopping at the local Co-op and being a member of Societies in the village,

I know that you have received letters and presentations from other residents and the Dumbah Association so I will not repeat many of the points they make (My wife and I suffer I'll health) but I conclude by asking that simple common sense will apply and that the lane is united under the banner of Prestbury
