Related subject: Nar Valley ward - Breckland

1. Do you have suggestions about where your ward boundaries should be?

- The local authority boundary does not reflect the pattern of community life - Beachamwell residents align closer to the Bedingfeld ward, as opposed to Nar Valley. There has been a spread of housing developments within the Narborough area, and I believe as this area expands, the less Beachamwell residents will feel service delivery is fair to our village. Our electorate rates are similar to that of Bedingfeld, too.

2. Where do people in your area go to access local facilities, such as shops and leisure activities?

- Due to rural location, mostly online shopping is our only option. During the Winter months, access roads between Beachamwell and Swaffham (via Drymere) are constantly having flood issues, which means we get locked to the village. Breckland/NCC refuse to ice the road between us and our closest town, despite several pleas made to the council via our Parish Council. Where required to purchase something in-person, we go to King's Lynn Hardwick Retail Park for food and Swaffham for fuel.

3. Which areas do you identify as your local community?
