## Comment text:

I am objecting to the proposal to the Boundary Commission's proposed changes to the ward boundaries for Baildon to exclude parts of Lower Baildon along the river Aire, and to include parts of Eldwick.

Baildon is a small town which historically has geographical boundaries of the River Aire and the Moor. When 'Beating the Bounds', a walk round the boundary of the town, the rugged landscape marking the boundaries is obvious and should not be changed.

To cut Eldwick up and place part in Baildon does not make sense as there are no public transport links. The only road link is narrow and there is no pedestrian links other than hiking over the glen moor. Eldwick as a whole is served by public transport and good road links with Bingley.
