Related subject: Campbell Park and Old Woughton ward

Residential areas should be kept in the same ward as the 'local center' (shops and other amenities) that the residents of that area use. For example residents of Bolbeck park use the shops and school in Willen, so should be in the same ward as Willen.

Willen Park north and Willen Park South (currently in different wards) should be in the same ward as Willen. It makes no sense for Willen Park North to be in a different ward to Willen Park South .

People who live in Pennyland use the shops and schools in Neath hill, but they are in the same polling district as Bolbeck park which is on the other side of a major barrier - the canal!

Downs Barn and Downhead Park are sibling estates and should be kept together.

Ashland has strong ties to Netherfield as that's where the schools and medical facilities for the residents are, but it is in the same ward as Simpson which it has nothing in common with.

People in Old Groveway have more connections with Tinker's Bridge than with Simpson, but it is treated as part of Simpson when the geography means it is more like part of Tinker's Bridge.
