Hello, I have been a resident of Woughton Park for 30 years, of which Woughton Park is now part of the fairly newly established Parish of Old Woughton. My husband and I love where we live but with now an aging population on the estate on and it also being the smallest estate in Milton Keynes we now have no bus service, no meeting place except on the street, or in each others house and not much contact with other parts of our bounded areas: which are Passmore and Woughton on the Green. Woughton on the Green has no meeting hall or anywhere to meet for a coffee and a chat except for St Mary's Church, open on a Saturday morning for 2 hours and the church is not where everyone want to go for a coffee as it is a ancient building with no inefficient heating and conveniences. Our OWP parish, I believe is the only parish without a community meeting place and I think this needs to be discussed with resident. Much money is paid via the OWP to our Patch allotment but there are very few people from Woughton Park using as allotment holders and hardly any fro other parts of the parish. Woughton Park, of 75 houses, was the first estate to be built for workers of the old Development Corporation and I feel that historically we should be recognised for this by having our own meeting hall build were we all can congregate at time. We are a sociable community after all and would like the young people who are now moving onto the estate to have somewhere to gravitate to for varying event. Well, that's my view as how things should be. Thank you.
