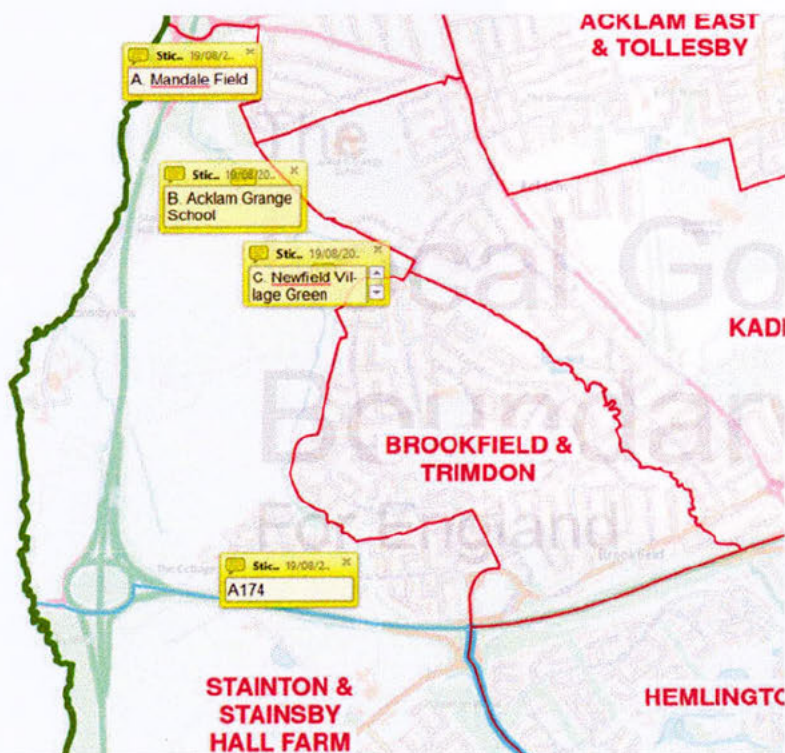
MIDDLESBROUGH WARD REVIEW

Further to the publication of the Draft Local Government Boundary Commission for England's report for Middlesbrough I would like to object to the following green spaces being removed from their current wards and placed into the newly proposed ward name of Stainton & Stainsby Hall Farm.

- A. Mandale Field/Meadows currently in Ayresome Ward. Access via Mandale Road.
- B. The field next to Acklam Grange Secondary School and currently in Kader Ward. Direct access from residents living in Trimdon and Kader Ward and within 10 minutes walking distance from Mandale Road
- C. Newfield Village Green currently in Trimdon Ward. Direct access from residents living in Trimdon and Kader Ward and within 15 minutes walking distance from Mandale Road

The A174 should be the cut off point for the Stainton & Stainsby Hall Farm Ward. There are currently no plans to build housing on any of the green spaces mentioned above **A, B & C**, therefore there would be no change to electoral numbers now or in the future. The ward arrangements for this area have worked well for decades and should remain unchanged.

Based on the statement above and the map below I trust the Boundary Commission have enough information to reinstate the green spaces back into the wards they currently reside.
