Comment text:

The freshney ward in NELC has it's own needs and identity that does not sit within the suggested boundary changes. The proposed merge with West Marsh isn't suitable as the needs of each area differ greatly in terms of health, business, social needs, deprivation and policing.

By merging the two areas will creat a lack of opportunity for those in these areas. The west marsh requires additional support and funding due to deprivation which may no longer be available to the residents once a merger with the freshney ward happens. No change has been required and councillors and other agencies have served the needs of all residents for decades and understand the difference in the two communities.

The same can be said for the move to the wolds for other residents. Their needs will not be met due to differences with the rural communities and the whole community will suffer because of this. Local areas need to be together supported by agencies who understand their needs and requirements.
