Meriden residents access many NHS services at Balsall Common Health Centre, as it is the main hub for our surgery. That, along with the shopping centre, a Post Office and library (which is currently open for many more hours than the Meriden branch) means that a trip there, by car or by a very limited bus service makes the journey worthwhile. As the direct route goes through Berkswell and Balsall Common having the same Borough Councillors seems to be in the best interest of us all.

Moving the boundaries to include Meriden with Bickenhill, Catherine de Barnes, Hampton-in-Arden, Marston Green and Chelmsley Wood - the latter 2 of which there is NO DIRECT PUBLIC TRANSPORT to, and only Chelmsley Wood having a shopping area seems to be detrimental to all. We seldom seem to see our borough councillors as it is ,when we are so close. What chance do we have of building any relationship with them if they have to cover the wider area.
