**Related subject:** Macclesfield Tytherington and Macclesfield Central

I support the proposal that the area where I have lived for over 40 years should be included in the new Macclesfield Central Ward. Our area, which includes many terraced houses, is enclosed south of the rail line and the River Bollin, and has very close natural links to the town of Macclesfield and its main shopping area. These are all within a few minutes walking distance, crossing Hibel Road by the footbridge or the pelican crossing on Cumberland St.

We consider the old and new Tytherington estates to be quite separate from our area both geographically and socially.

Another minor point is that historically our Polling Station is in the present Central Ward of Macclesfield.

I also support the proposal that Bollinbrook Estate is no longer in the Tytherington Ward but becomes part of the new Broken Cross and Upton Ward, because historically Bollingbrook has always had strong links with the Prestbury Road and Upton areas.

One other observation: I would have thought Beechwood Mews and Beech Farm Drive should be in the Tytherington Ward, as both are north of the River Bollin.
