#### LGBCE Electoral Review – Phase 2

Further to your letter of 21 January 2025 granting the Council a further six weeks to submit a scheme for new divisions across Somerset, I now attach the Council's submission, which was unanimously approved, at the meeting of the Council's Constitution and Governance Committee on 3 March 2025.

Each of the proposed divisions have been devised against the background of the three criteria, namely electoral equality, effective and convenient local government, and community identity and interests.

The ten proposed two member divisions have been identified as particularly relevant to the community identity and interests criterion, and although the Council was predominantly seeking single member divisions, it was recognised that these areas would be better served by not dividing them but keeping the community together as a single entity.

The Council's geographical area breaks down into certain topographical types as Somerset is an array of moorland, low lying wetland (the Levels), seacoast and several ranges of hills (the Quantocks, the Mendips, Blackdown Hills) and valleys.

Wherever possible, the proposed divisions have been designed reflect and retain the surrounding natural environment, therefore, many of the divisions are almost self-selecting. Several communities are also very close to the borders with other local authorities (Frome,

Yeovil, Wellington, Chard etc) and this creates some difficulties with devising divisions which meet the electoral equality criterion.

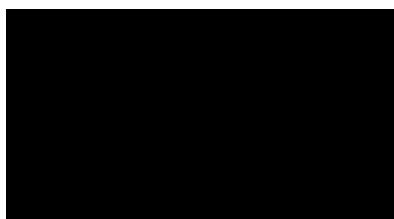
Taunton Town Council only came into being on 1 April 2023 and whole Town Council Wards have been used as building blocks for that area as it is in the process of establishing its' identity. Somerset Council has been reluctant to put forward suggestions which could lead to those Wards being sub-divided at this stage. It is considered that any changes would be better brought about when the Town Council has had a longer existence and if changes are required would be more appropriately brought about by a community governance review in due course.

As stated above, the Council's submission was unanimously agreed by the Constitution and Governance Committee for submission in whole, however, some members of the council have identified a small number of areas which they believe would benefit from some small; amendments and have asked that I forward some suggested alternatives to you for consideration.

I attach these suggestions to this letter to enable you to record them as being from the members concerned and not forming part of the Council's submission, which should be considered as submitted.

The Council extends its grateful thanks to the Commission for extending the time for the Council to make a submission.

## Council Electoral Division Submission



## **Introduction**

This is Somerset Council's submission setting out a proposed structure of electoral divisions for the local authority from 2027. In order to develop consensus to respond to the Commission's call for submissions, the Council established a cross-party working group to undertake a detailed evaluation and analysis of proposed options. The Working Group decided, due the limited time available to respond, to use existing polling districts as the foundational building blocks to develop a new scheme. This scheme was subsequently developed with further input from Members and approved by the Constitution and Governance Committee,

The Council had expressed the view that, wherever possible, its preference was for predominantly single member divisions to ensure that there was clear accountability for local communities, as set out in the Unitary Business Case. Additionally, the Council had decided that there was a requirement for 96 councillors. In devising a council wide pattern of electoral divisions, and following the detailed analytical work detailed below, a scheme reproduced the most satisfactory outcome. This scheme allows for 76 single member divisions and 10 two-member divisions (86 divisions in total). The two-member divisions were included because, in each case, the unity of the community would be better served by two members.

The Council accepted that some compromises would be necessary to enable it to draw up a Council-wide scheme and worked on a cross-party basis to achieve the most equitable and logical scheme, given the limitations of time.

The overall electorate of Somerset, based on the projected 2030 figures is 467,274; the target figure for 96 divisions per member was 4,867, and the Council has endeavoured largely to stay within 10% of that figure.

Ultimately, the requirement to consider community identity together with topographical reasons, has resulted in some divisions being slightly outside of the 10% tolerance originally sought.
