The proposed area for Hammerton has the appearance of joining together left over areas which have no commonality of community, no transport links and are geographically disparate. For example, Staveley is across the A1 and beyond several river crossings. Long Marston is on the other side of the Nidd and several miles away from Green Hammerton let alone Staveley. The proposed area appears far from compliant with the principles of the reorganisation.

The theming of the area on the A59 rather than public transport contradicts planning policies governing the development of the proposed Maltkilns development.
