To Whom it May Concern

I am writing on behalf of Hunmanby Parish Council regarding the Electoral Reviews.

It was unanimously agree to submit the following comments:

- Division Name

Hunmanby Parish Council support the inclusion of 'Hunmanby' in the division name as Hunmanby is a service village with a large population of nearly 3,000 and forms a significant part of any division in which it is included.

- Effective and Convenient Government

Section 2.16 of the LGBCE Technical Guidance for Electoral Reviews states:

"We also seek to help councils at all levels by putting in place electoral arrangement which are conducive to effective and convenient local government for both them and the electorate in initiating reviews or responding to requests for reviews."

Having reviewed the proposals put forward by the LGBCE for the new Hunmanby division, we are concerned that the inclusion of small rural villages is not conducive to effective local representation for a large village like Hunmanby where most of the issues encountered are akin to an urban town.

The current arrangement for Hunmanby and Sherburn division is more effective in terms of local representation as Sherburn, while smaller than Hunmanby, mirrors Hunmanby having a Primary School, GP Surgery, Industrial areas and associated Highways issues.
