NEW ELECTORAL ARRANGEMENTS

April 2026

Currently there are:

- 47 councillors
- 21 wards
- 5 single-councillor, 6 two-councillor, and 10 three-councillor wards

We are proposing:

- 48 councillors
- 22 wards
- 6 single-councillor, 6 two-councillor, and 10 three-councillor wards

A public consultation is open until
6 July 2026



We aim to make sure York
councillors represent a similar
number of electors



Currently there is:

- One ward that is more than 10% away from the average number of electors per ward
- No wards that are more than 30% away from the average

Our proposals mean that:

- No wards will be more than 10% away from the average number of electors per ward
- Each councillor will represent an average of 3,542 electors
