Currently there are:

- 50 councillors
- 20 wards
- 10 three-councillor wards and 10 two-councillor wards

We are proposing:

- 41 councillors
- 18 wards
- 6 three-councillor wards, 11 two-councillor wards and 1 single-councillor ward

A public consultation is open until
6 July 2026



We aim to make sure Darlington
councillors represent a similar
number of electors



Currently there are:

- 7 wards that are more than 10% away from the average number of electors per ward
- No wards that are more than 30% away from the average

Our proposals mean that:

- One ward will be more than 10% away from the average number of electors per ward
- Each councillor will represent an average of 2,194 electors
