The views of Wrington Parish Council are below.

Wrington Parish Council is happy with the present boundaries of Wrington ward. The ward includes the parishes of Wrington, Brockley, Butcombe and Cleeve which share a rural situation with villages as a focus for each parish.

Cleeve village and parish in particular, although smaller than Wrington village and parish is similar in having a village centre with surrounding countryside and a main A road. Cleeve parish includes the A370, Wrington parish the A38. Both parishes together with Brockley parish are adjacent to Bristol airport and considerably affected by it.

Wrington Parish Council also feels strongly that the Wrington North East parish ward should not be separated from the parish South West parish ward by any District ward boundary change. The 2 Wrington parish wards have historic links and in particular it would be anomalous if Wrington Parish were to include Bristol airport but Wrington ward did not, and could cause difficulties for the representation of residents' views. This anomaly would occur if Wrington NE parish ward were to be included in a ward other than Wrington ward.

If the general population increase in North Somerset dictates that Wrington ward must increase in size, then the inclusion of Burrington parish would be the most suitable. There are many links between Burrington parish and Wrington ward. Wrington Anglican benefice includes the churches of Wrington, Redhill, Butcombe, St Mary's Langford and Burrington. Wrington primary school is in a federation with Burrington primary school. Burrington parish is a similar small size to Butcombe parish.
